- 1. Refer to Workshop Manual, section 501-08: Exterior Trim and Ornamentation, and remove the affected A-pillar moulding.
- 2. Install new retaining clips.
- 3. Refer to Workshop Manual, section 501-08: Exterior Trim and Ornamentation, and install the affected A-pillar moulding.
